This week the Eco team conducted a 'Secret Mission' to find out if all children are keeping the school rules regarding healthy tuck which is a requirement of the national and local Healthy Schools' agenda. Sadly and very disappointingly, a large number of children are bringing crisps, chocolate bars and even sweets into school for morning break.

The school rule, in line with the strict Healthy Schools award guidance, requires the children to bring in fruit on a Monday to Thursday and as a special concession, we allow the children to have a 'treat day' on a Friday. Crisps or chocolate bars only please. No sweets.

It is very important that <u>all children</u> comply with this rule. Early Years children in Nursery and Reception are provided with fruit and milk everyday and all children in Years 1 to 6 should bring fruit (Fresh/ dried fruit/ raisins etc and a drink of water or milk only). The Eco team are currently consulting with the children to think of a suitable class reward system to promote this very important aspect of school life. We seek parental support and understanding with this requirement upon schools.



There is a major change in the Wrexham Council's policy regarding debt on school meal accounts, implemented with effect from 05/11/18.

Wrexham School Meals are unfortunately no longer able to continue allowing parents and guardians of primary school pupils to run up debts on meal accounts, and from 05/11/18 you must ensure that all school meals are paid for in advance. This is the same system currently in place for high school pupils in Wrexham.

Any existing debts must be cleared by that date, and they will not serve any meals to pupils whose accounts are in debt, you will need to provide a packed lunch.
