National Reading Tests Trials

During this week and next week, a small number of children from year 2 to 6 are taking part in a trial of the Welsh Government personalised adaptive assessments in reading.

Over the next three years, personalised adaptive assessments will be implemented to replace the paper based National tests. On a positive note, the assessments change according to the children's ability to respond to the questions set. Therefore in theory, they provide a more accurate and useful assessment of a child's progress than the current 'Year group' based assessments. So far Years 3,4 and 5 have participated in the assessments and the teachers have been very pleased with the children's response. Da iawn pawb.
