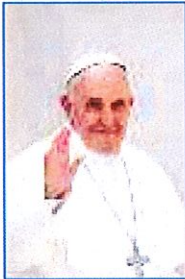

St Mary's have progressed through to the winning school gala which will take place on Wednesday 3rd April.



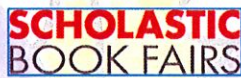
Y5 Glan Llyn

There will be half price book sale fair from Thursday 4th April until Thursday 11th April. Any proceeds will be ploughed straight into providing additional resources for our children.



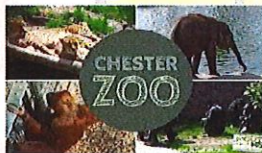
Y5 Gwenfro Assembly

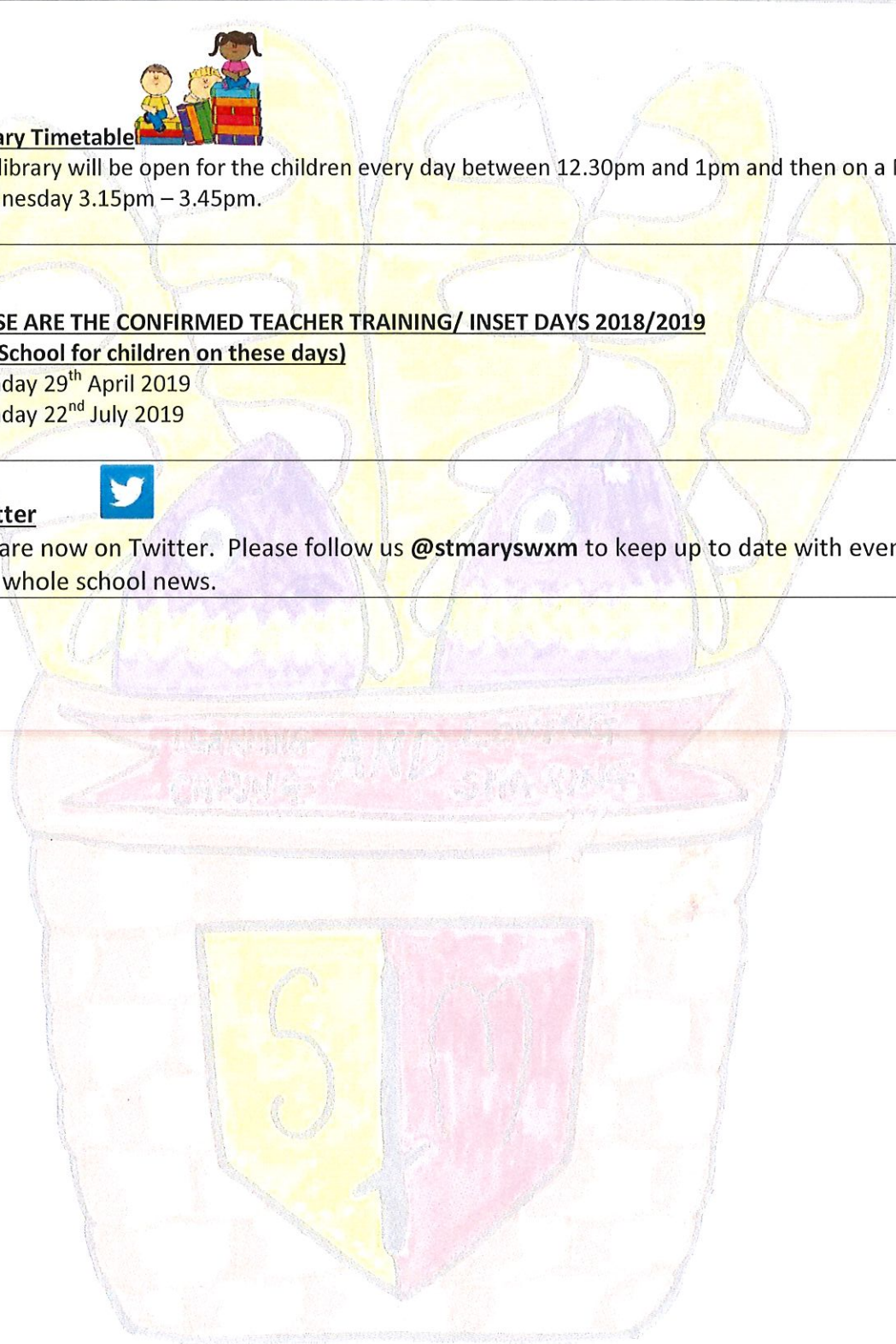
