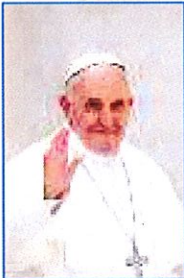

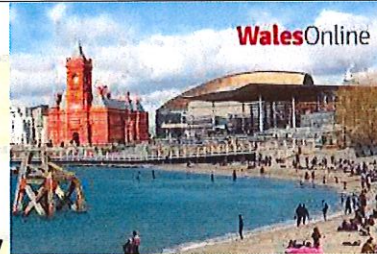
Our Inspection report will be published on the school website and the Estyn website on 3rd September ready to start the new school year. Further information to follow.
