Remembering David Lord VC

Next week, Eleri from Wrexham Museum will be visiting all classes from Y2 to Y6 to deliver workshops based on David Lord VC, a former pupil of St Mary's Catholic Primary School. RAF Flight Lieutenant David Lord received the Victoria Cross after his death in 1944 'for displaying supreme valour and self-sacrifice' in the Battle of Arnhem in the Netherlands during the Second World War.

The children will be making decorative bunting for display at a celebration event on 19th September in the Memorial Hall to commemorate David Lord's 75th Anniversary.
