#### Covid-19-Update.

As per the latest update from the Prime Minister, Welsh Government and Public Health Wales, schools remain open until further notice. We have been advised to continue to adhere to strict guidance regarding health and hygiene, e.g. routine handwashing at regular intervals (Please see school poster regarding handwashing.) We have also been advised to inform parents that if anyone has a 'high temperature of 37.8 degrees or above' or has a 'new continuous cough', they should stay at home for 7 days. Anyone who has come into contact with someone diagnosed with Coronavirus, must also stay at home for 7 days and must notify school IMMEDIATELY.

We are asking that all families adhere to this advice.

The Senior WCBC Educational Social Worker has provided this statement for all schools: "Currently schools are open and the guidance we have received from Public Health Wales means that pupils should attend as usual. Therefore any absence should be unauthorised."

The consultation period has now opened in regards to the potential relocation of St Mary's to 'Nine Acre Field' to a brand new, 'state of the art' school.

The Local Authority are keen to seek the views of interested parties before the planning application is made.

The proposals include a two-storey school building with direct access to outdoor classrooms, playgrounds, playing fields, a forest school, a staff car park and parent/ visitor car parks and drop off zones. This is a very exciting prospect for St Mary's school community in light of the increasing limitations of our current site.

The consultation information will also be displayed in Wrexham Library and there is a drop-in session planned at the Memorial Hall, Bodhyfryd Wrexham, LL12 7AG on 19<sup>th</sup> March from 3:30pm-7pm.

# Swimming Gala Information


The information we have received to date is that the swimming gala will be going ahead on 18<sup>th</sup> March.


