Remote Home Learning Plan



Communication— Seesaw will be used as the main method of communication between teacher and parent/ carer. There is a message function on Seesaw for private communication should this be needed. Seesaw will be used to inform parents of the suggested daily learning tasks/ opportunities. Well-being Message — As ever, our first priority is the health and well-being of all our pupils and staff. We want to maintain contact with our whole school family and for this reason, each and every single school day your child is away from school, we will contact you via Seesaw to check that everything is ok. You can also contact Mrs Acton at anytime during the school day on the school email address and she will get back to you via email or on the phone, as soon as possible.



Remote Learning Platforms e.g. Hwb & Seesaw — All children have access to Seesaw and all children from Y1-Y6 have access to Hwb (Office 365, Flipgrid, JiT, Google Classroom etc.) to provide home learning for your child. Daily information about learning tasks set will be shared with parents on Seesaw. Children will be able to use Seesaw/ Google Classroom to share their daily home learning with their teacher. Teachers will 'check in' with their class a minimum of twice daily; once first thing in the morning and once at the end of the school day. Teachers will provide feedback to children about their learning in line with our usual feedback policy. Children who have any additional learning needs or an Individual Educational Plan (IEP) will have an additional Seesaw account where they can communicate with Mrs Ruth Williams (ALNCo.)



Physical learning resources—A pack of physical resources will be provided for each child while they are away from school, as appropriate. This will include items such as digital passport/ Login for Hwb, paper, workbooks, pencil, scissors, timestables grids, 100 square, spelling and vocabulary sheets, tool kits etc. and any other age specific resources.



Suggested Daily Learning Plan—A suggested daily learning plan will be provided for each year group. This is an outline plan to ensure that all children continue to access a range of learning experiences and opportunities across the curriculum. The detail of this plan will be communicated via Seesaw and will be appropriate to each year group and support the needs of all learners. If parents/ carers require any support with any learning activity, they should contact the teacher via Seesaw.



School Website Proposed School Closure Zone—This section on the school website under the 'CHILDREN' dropdown has been set up as a central resource zone for parents to access useful websites, links to games, suggested Daily Learning Plans, Prayer/Thought for the Day/Reflection from Mrs Acton and any relevant updates regarding the changing situation.
