## MESSAGES FROM MRS ACTON

What a busy start to the new school year! A huge thank you for all your support, especially at drop off and collection times. Your cooperation to ensure our whole school family is kept safe at this challenging time is very much appreciated.

Self isolation Home Learning—Next week we will be sharing our 'Home Learning Contingency plans' to ensure continuity of learning for all year groups if your child needs to self isolate due to Covid 19. There will be a 4 stage approach which is in line with Public Health Wales isolation guidance: Stage 1 -Child is unwell with unrelated illness. (No school work provided) Stage 2— Child is awaiting Covid 19 test due to Covid 19 recognised symptoms (approx. 1- 3 days). Stage 3— Positive Covid 19 test for child or member of household. (positive child isolation for 10 days, household members isolate for 14 days) Stage 4— Positive test in Class/ Contact group. (Self isolation of whole class/ contact group for 14 days.)

The plans will shared with parents on the school website and via Seesaw. If you have any questions, please ask.

<u>Home/ School Reading Records-</u> Over the coming weeks, we will be reviewing how we record the children's reading experiences in school and the way in which parents can communicate when and how children are reading at home. Again, information will be shared via Seesaw, the school website and via email.

<u>Healthy Snack</u>—A polite reminder to all parents that a healthy snack i.e. fruit or vegetables should be provided for all children in Years 1-6 between Monday and Thursday please. On Friday children can have chocolate/ crisps as a treat. **No sweets** 

<u>Seesaw</u>—Please ensure all parents sign up to Seesaw as this is the main form of communication between teachers and parents. Diolch.

<u>Coats</u>— All children should wear a coat with a hood to school each day please as we will aim to have outside breaks/ learning opportunities, wherever possible.
