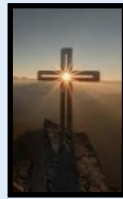
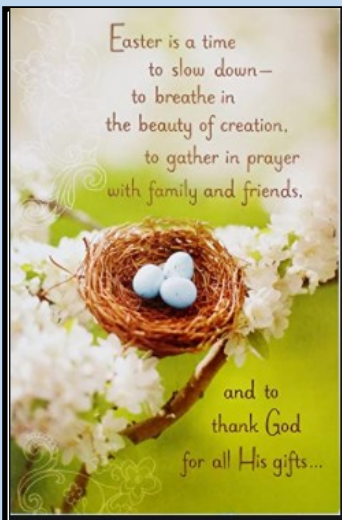
## Pasg Hapus Happy Easter

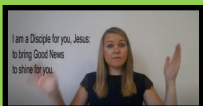
## MAKATON SIGN OF THE WEEK
