Covid Restrictions– School Arrangements

Thanks to all who are doing their bit to keep everyone safe by wearing your mask and maintaining 2 m social distancing on site. **Your support and respect for our whole school family is very much appreciated.**

In this school, those who are medically exempt from wearing a mask are **politely asked to wear a lanyard** to avoid staff stopping the flow of 'traffic' moving through the school and to make it clear to other parents that you are exempt from wearing a mask **rather than refusing to comply with school arrangements.**

Spare masks are now available on the gates for those who forget their masks.

After half term, in agreement with the Chair of Governors, those who forget/ do not want to wear an exemption lanyard/ display badge **will be expected to wait at the gate** for their child to be taken in/ brought out once all classes have entered/left.




