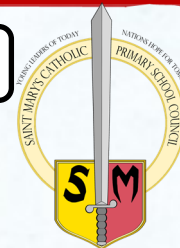




School Council & Super Ambassadors Minutes—Friday 3rd February 2023—1.30pm
