## Universal Free School Meals- rollout to include ALL pupils

As communicated at the end of last year, from today the Welsh Government is funding Universal Free School Meals for **ALL** primary aged children from Reception to Year 6. This means that parents no longer need to pay for school meals in St. Mary's. If parents are in receipt of eligible benefits and support payments, please make an application to the Local Authority if you have not previously done so. Making this application will allow eligible parents to access school uniform and equipment grants, and will also ensure that our school receives the correct amount of funding from Welsh Government. <u>Please note</u>- It is vital that all parents pre-order school meals each day via the Parent Pay website to ensure that the cook can order and prepare enough food for everyone. <u>Teachers should not be ordering meals in school</u>. If you have any questions, please ask the school office.

### Just by way of a few quick reminders at the start of a new school year

### **Attendance & Punctuality**

- School gates open at 08:45 in the morning and close at 08:55. Gates open at 11:30 for Nursery collection and again at 15:15 at the end of the school day for Reception to Year 6.
- Children who arrive after 08:55 and before 09:15 will be marked late in the register





• The school registers close after 09:15 after which time, children will be marked absent

### Uniform and Presentation

- Full school uniform should be worn every day except on PE days. PE kit may be worn to school on class PE day.
- ALL children should wear **black school shoes**. Black trainers <u>are not</u> school uniform.
- Long hair (below shoulder-length) should be tied back
- Hairstyles should be kept sensible. Shaven heads (including extreme variance in hair grades and shaved lines in the hair), hair colours, tramlines, excessive spikes, fancy designs and coloured braids etc. are not acceptable and are not part of our school uniform policy.
- One pair of small stud earrings may be worn to school. No hoop earrings or other fancy earrings

#### Healthy Schools' awards

- In accordance with our Platinum Eco and Healthy Schools' Awards and Welsh Government guidance, we ask that all children bring a refillable water bottle to school to drink during the day- no juice/ fizzy drinks please (Year 1-Year 6)
- All children should bring fruit/ vegetable sticks only for snack- Monday to Thursday. On Friday, children are allowed to bring a 'treat' for their morning snack, if they wish- e.g. chocolate/ biscuits, crisps- no sweets/ lollies please.
  <u>Please note</u>:- Nursery and reception receive a healthy fruit snack each day (£1 per week)
